Common Core math text books are purposely disposable and say so in the front of each book.

Approx. two pounds each and 8.5x11x1 inches=93.5 inches cubed which is 0.0541 cubic feet.

Two volumes per year means four pounds per year and 0.1082 cubic feet per subject per year.

Assuming four subjects per year means sixteen pounds and 0.43287 cubic feet per student/year.
