Personal Documents & Money <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copies of important papers, addresses and phone numbers, • Genealogy Records • Patriarchal Blessing • Legal Documents (Birth/Marriage certificates, Wills, Passports, Contracts, etc) • Vaccination Papers Insurance Policies • Cash (small bills and coins) • Credit card • Pre-paid Phone Card • Zip-Lock bags to put items in • Scriptures • Journal • Spare set of car and house keys
